


In 10 days is the Rebbe's birthday. Every year we create a 10 day birthday booklet to help you come prepared and give the Rebbe a gift.

There was a man who used to be very particular to learn גמרא at a fixed time every day in the Shul in his city. One day he looked really stressed and sad. A good friend asked him why and he said that his only son was really not well and he had to have a very complicated surgery that there was a big chance that it would not help. His sons life was in danger! This man was a Belzer chossid but he had some Lubavitch friends who suggested that he write to the Rebbe. The man wrote a letter to the Rebbe but was certain he wouldn't get an answer in time for his son's surgery which was in a few

To his surprise 3 days later he received a letter from the Rebbe that was send express mail – it was the regular saying that the Rebbe would go to the הל – there were also two words written in the Rebbes handwriting – "בשורות טובות".

Then there were two lines written with a typewriter, I am sure that you say חתח every day and daven like the מנהג is. This was surprising as this man wasn't a lubavitcher חסיד so he didn't say חחח or daven the same מנהג as דום because it wasn't his מנהג. The man took upon himself to do this as it may help his son. The day of the surgery came and when their son was taken in to the last minute checkups before the surgery – the doctors called the parents in – therewas no need for surgery! The symptoms had disappeared as if they were never there!

The man continued to say חתת and רמבם until today.

### Story of the Rebbe

A Gerrer chossid related the following story: 'I met the Rebbe personally only once, when a friend took me to 770 to get כום של ברכה.

We waited in line, slowly inching forward as we came nearer to the Rebbe's place and to our turn to receive our wine and ברכה.

'Now (as you all know), during kos shel brocho there were in fact 2 separate lines, One passed in front of the Rebbe, and the other passed behind the Rebbe. The Rebbe would alternate between distributing the wine to the line in front of him and to the line behind him. However since i had never been, I didn't know

However since i had never been, I didn't know any of this at the time.

'Imagine my surprise, therefore, when, just as I reached the Rebbe's place, the Rebbe abruptly did an about-face, and turned his back to me! I was left feeling shock, and humiliation, and wondering what I had done to deserve this! 'It took only a few moments until the Rebbe turned back to my line, and I feel that he recognized the hurt feelings from my expression. In a marked departure for his regular practice, the Rebbe – after pouring a bit of wine into my cup – put down his becher, and reached out and shook hands with me! Thats how much the Rebbe cared to make me feel comfortable!

The Rebbe listened to his questions and then said, "There is a Yid in Maryland that you should discuss this with. His name is Weinberg" Rabbi Weinberg was shocked and ask the Rebbe to repeat what he said. He then said 'My name is Weinberg!!" The Rebbe answered him, if that is the case you should know that a person has to speak to himself!! The Rebbe was teaching him that ultimately we know what is best for us and he switched from being a psychologist to being the Rov of his community.
