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THE REBBE; OUR FATHER DAY #1 | SUNDAY, 18 SHEVAT

On Lag Baomer of 5710 the Rebbe spoke about the imprisonment of the Frierdiker Rebbe and a strong lesson we can learn from it.

In the Frierdiker Rebbe's personal writings of his imprisonment in 5627, the Frierdiker Rebbe describes how when he thought about his family it would put him in a not-good mood and he would try to take those thoughts out of his mind. The Frierdiker Rebbe concludes with the words, "אָבָא, אָבא, אָבא, אָבא." "Father, saintly father..!"

The Frierdiker Rebbe is giving us advice: When a person is not so happy, the solution to pick themselves up is to connect to the Rebbe, by picturing his face and learning his Torah. By doing so, we will realize that we have nothing to worry about, because we are connected to the Rebbe, our father! "צריכים אנו לדעת שיש לנו אבא קדישא... ובמילא, אין מה לדאוג" "We need to know that we have a "holy father," and therefore, there is no cause to worry."

STORY

On a number of occasions, the Rebbetzin expressed that the Chasidim are her children, as the Rebbe himself did during Birchas Habonim of 5712 when the Rebbe said the now-famous line "since you learn in the Rebbe's Yeshivah, you are the Rebbe's children."

Rabbi Uri Holtzman's parents were very close to the Rebbetzin and would visit her in her home on many occasions. Rabbi Holtzman Relates: In the later years, when my parents visited New York with us kids, we always came to see the Rebbetzin. And even though she was a person of authority, she felt like an aunt or grandmother, a member of the family to us.

I recall on one of our visits when I was about nine years old, my two brothers and I were playing in the house which seemed enormous to us. "Wow, you have such a big house," I said to the Rebbetzin, "but there are no kids here. So what do you need such a big house for?"

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Before she could answer, I realized that there was an obvious explanation, so I said, "The kids must be all grown up and they don't live here anymore."

The Rebbetzin's response to a little boy who didn't realize that he was asking an embarrassing question was brilliant, "Richtig, Richtig. Aleh Chasidim Zeinen Di Rebbe's kinder – You are correct. All the Chasidim are the Rebbe's children."

She also handled my younger brother Noach brilliantly. While she was serving us ice cream, my brother asked to scoop it out for himself. Of course, he was likely to make a mess, but she didn't refuse him for that reason. Instead, she said, "If you are going to take it yourself, you're not going to take enough." And how could a little kid object to getting more ice cream?

In a sicha from Simchas Beis Hashoevah 5721, the Rebbe spoke very strongly about going on Shlichus and that now, after that sicha, people will begin to accept Shlichus, no matter how far or what the conditions may be. The Rebbe said, "יחר – הרי זה מעבר לרחוב, או מעבר לים, או רחוק יותר – הרי זה באופן שנוסעים יחד עמו זה באופן שנוסעים יחד עמו." במקום ההוא

"Whether it be the next block over [where they move on shlichus], overseas, or even farther, all of the Rebbeim travel together with them, and whichever place they come to, the Rebbeim are there with them." Someone may be very close to the "tziyon" but, spiritually, they are very far apart, like two people standing next to each other but with their backs facing each other. On the other hand, a Shliach can be very far physically, yet completely close and united with the Rebbe spiritually, in every way.

STORY

Rabbi Nosson Gurary, shliach of the Rebbe to Buffalo, New York, and one of the earliest Shluchim on campus, was once going through a very difficult time. The university had moved its facilities to a new location, a sprawling campus surrounded by a lake, from where it was difficult for students to access the Chabad House. Suddenly, ten years into his Shlichus, he was struggling to get a Minyan on Shabbos and Yom Tov.

"I once went into the Rebbe, and I wrote how lonely it is on a Yom Tov or on a Shabbos. The Rebbe said to me, 'Vibald Az Du Tust Di Arbet Fun Dem Rebbe'n Dem Shver, Iz Er Mit Dir - Since you are doing the work of my father-in-law, the Rebbe, he is with you.' Then the Rebbe said, 'Un Mir Zeinen Oichet Tzuzamen - And we are also together.' The Rebbe told me clearly that he is with me, and he knows what I'm going through. This is what Pikuach Nefesh is, and this is what you have to do."

Rabbi Gurary adds, "He always let me know how much Nachas he had from the work on campus." Difficulties and failures, especially financial ones, can overwhelm a person, blinding him of past successes and overall achievements.

In many letters to dispirited Shluchim and Shluchos, the Rebbe uplifted them simply by putting things into context and showing them the bigger picture of their overall successful Shlichus. Being that it is so difficult to judge success in Ruchiniyusdike work like Shlichus, and being that spiritual success can sometimes feel shortlived [doing merely one mitzvah with another can feel like a very small act], Shluchim sometimes hadn't even realized the impact they were having until the Rebbe pointed it out to them.

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ACHDUS OF CHASSIDIM

DAY #3 | TUESDAY, 20 SHEVAT

In the Farbrengen of Yud Shevat 5711, where the Rebbe officially accepted the Nesius, the Rebbe spoke about how the Chassidim are united as one family. The Rebbe said that when we are each connected to the Rebbe, automatically we are connected to each other, all the Chassidim. And, through that achdus, of all the Chassidim, Hashem will help us to fulfill the Rebbe's ratzon and do everything the Rebbe wants of us! If this is true for Chassidim, how much more so regarding the Shluchim, who are spread all around the world, fulfilling the ratzon of the Rebbe!

STORY

The Tzemach Tzedek once had to go to Petersburg (the capital of Russia) for many meetings. The government wanted to make rules about the kind of education the Yidden can have! The Tzemach Tzedek obviously would never agree to make any change in pure Yiddishe education, and the government was very mad at him, to say the least! In those days in Russia, it was very dangerous for the Tzemach Tzedek to publicly act this way and go against the government.

One of the Rabbonim who was there asked the Tzemach Tzedek how he could do this, There are so many Yidden who need the Tzemach Tzedek to guide them in life, so how can he do something dangerous and risk his own life? Without him, many Yidden won't know how a Yid should live, they won't have anyone to ask their questions too!

The Tzemach Tzedek said he needs to do what he is doing and if something would Chas Veshalom happen to him, there are two ways to help that all of these Yidden should know how to act as a Yid and have people to speak to:

1) The Tzemach Tzedek's children can take over and teach and guide the Chassidim.

2) The unity of Chassidim will carry them until Moshiach.

The Rebbe told this story 100 years after the Histalkus of the Tzemach Tzedek. He said, "Now that the first reason isn't there anymore - only the

second. We need to know that when Chassidim work together, we have the Koach to bring Moshiach!"

STORY

"A Picture is worth a thousand words, goes the saying. A thousand pictures, then, speaks volumes more." These words are from the English foreword of the famous Sefer Hashluchim book, edited by the Rebbe.

During the Farbrengen of Shabbos Parshas Chayei Sarah 5750 that we learned above, the Rebbe suggested that in order to better capture the moment and allow this inspiration to be easily accessed, a mementoalbum from the Kinus should be published, which will include photographs of the participating Shluchim and their families, as well as some of the Torah thoughts and other ideas discussed during the Kinus.

In this manner, the Rebbe said, each Shliach, along with his wife and children, will be able to periodically look through the album and be reminded of the sense of Achdus at the Kinus, and receive a boost to efficiently fulfill their Shlichus.

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The Rebbe made special mention of the young children, saying that

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even they will be inspired by seeing their picture in the book, encouraging them to go on the right path when they grow older as well.

One year later, in time for the 5751 Kinus, a beautiful, full-color album was published and debuted at the Kinus.

This was the start of the well-known four-volume set of Sefer Hashluchim that we all know of today. The books serve as an inspiration to thousands of people on Shlichus around the world, materializing the Rebbe's vision for the project.

STORY

The inception of the famed "Released Time Program" can be uniquely credited with touching the lives of tens of thousands of Jewish children learning in the public school system throughout New York City. These were children who for the most part were unexposed to Yiddishkeit. The Rebbe displayed an extreme fondness for the program, going as far as to make it the only task a bochur could be excused from seder for!

Occasionally, regular children's rallies included participants from the "Mitvoch Sho'oh" during which the kids had the Zechus to see the Rebbe.

In one instance, however, on 19 Tishrei 5737, the third day of Chol Hamoed Sukkos, a gathering would be solely dedicated to the Released Time Program participants. There were many outstanding Giluyim that the Chassidim were Zoche to witness during that extraordinary occasion. This included seeing the Rebbe washing for challah for the gathering; something usually only done by Farbrengens. Furthermore, in 5730 the Rebbe discontinued the practice of holding Farbrengens in the Sukkah due to extreme pushing in the crowd and unsafe conditions.

On this occasion, however, the Rebbe ordered the rally to be held there. Throughout the Farbrengen Chassidim saw the tremendous Nachas

that the Rebbe had from this gathering.

Indeed the Rebbe himself expressed his

satisfaction to Rabbi Hodakov saying that the orderly fashion of the farbrengen was Berov Pe'er Vohodor!

A VIRTUAL KINUS DAY #6 | FRIDAY, 23 SHEVAT

On 13 Elul 5742, the Rebbe began the Farbrengen, like many other Farbrengens, speaking about how special it is that we're gathered here in the Rebbe's Shul, etc. Then the Rebbe spoke about the achdus of all the Chassidim at the Farbrengen, not only the Chassidim in 770 at the time but even the Chassidim around the world listening via live hookup. That by using technology, many more people can join and listen to the farbrengen, from all over the world. They are able to hear, live and clearly, all the Torah that is being said, which will inspire them to follow it. Especially, since it is much more powerful to hear something directly from the person saying it, then to hear it repeated by someone else.

That is what makes the farbrengen so special! That many Yidden, including Yidden who live far away, are gathered with Achdus and Ahavas Yisroel, which will cause more Torah & Mitzvos to happen. This achdus brings so much nachas to Hashem, that the farbrengen can accomplish anything!

STORY

THE FIRST LIVE HOOKUP

In the days leading to Yud Shevat Hagodol - 5730, Chassidim around the world began to get very excited. The Farbrengen was historic for many reasons but one reason stands out and it's all thanks to the idea of one Bochur learning in Kfar Chabad.

The Bochur suggested to Reb Itchke Gansbourg that for the occasion they make a live call to 770 so they can hear the farbrengen. After making sure that it was possible on their end they reached out to a Bochur in 770

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to make sure that their plan will work.

Shmulik Rivkin, a bochur with the technological skills necessary, who learned in 770, to arrange the hookup from that end was asked to take care of this project. Shmulik immediately said yes, and recruited his friend Chaim Boruch Halberstam (who was to later found WLCC) to begin working on the new project.

After they had arranged the technical aspects, Reb Itchke asked the Rebbe for permission to go through with the hookup. Reb Binyomin Klein soon gave over the answer: The Farbrengen was to be on Motzei Shabbos and the hookup would indeed take place. Erev Shabbos was the Siyum Sefer Torah of Moshiach. Shmulik and Chaim Boruch, together with Meny Wolff, videoed and recorded the entire event. It was not possible to transmit the recording live to Eretz Yisroel, as it was already Shabbos there. On Motzei Shabbos, at the beginning of the broadcast, they replayed the Erev Shabbos Siyum and Farebrengen and then the Yud Shvat Farbrengen began.

The first live hookup was to four locations: London, England; Chicago; Los Angeles; and the Zal of Yeshivas Kfar Chabad.

To cover the expenses of the broadcast it was decided to sell entry tickets to the Zal of the Yeshiva. The tickets were snapped up; people were worried that there would not be any left. Reb Lipa Kertzvill was in charge of the hall and selling the tickets. He worked hard to make it possible for more people to join in the hookup. When the time came, over one thousand people crammed into the Zal awaiting the beginning of the Farbrengen. The suspense was thick, no one knew what to expect. The telephone lines of those days, especially the overseas lines, were not very clear and usually filled with static. Finally, Meni Wolff came on the line and related all that had happened by the Siyum of Moshiach's Sefer Torah on Friday and over Shabbos including the Shabbos Farbrengen. Then the tape of the siyum was played. For many of the people in the crowd, certainly the younger people there, this was the first time they heard the Rebbe's voice. For an even larger percentage, this was the first time they heard the Rebbe say the Pesukim of Ata Hareisa with the special tune of Simchas Torah. The Maamar "Lehavin Inyan Ksivas Sefer Torah" was then played. It is impossible to describe the feelings in the room at the time.

Minutes after the tape of Friday's proceedings ended, the Yud Shvat Farbrengen began. With closed eyes, the Chassidim listened to the Rebbe's voice coming out of the speakers. Many had tears in their eyes as they participated in the Farbrengen of the Rebbe from overseas.
